Full hook-up sites require advance reservations.

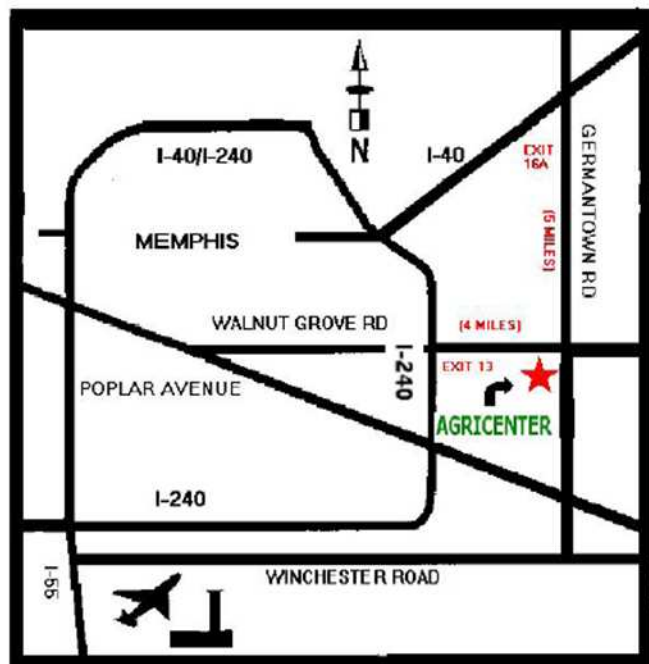

Travel I-40 west, exit Germantown Road (exit 16A). Go south on Germantown Road approximately 5 miles. You will go under the overpass at Walnut Grove Road, turn right at the stop light at Timbercreek. This is the entrance...Agricenter Expo Center is the large grayish white building, Show Place Arena is the large yellowish building on your left immediately past the Butcher Shop Restaurant.

From Little Rock, Arkansas:

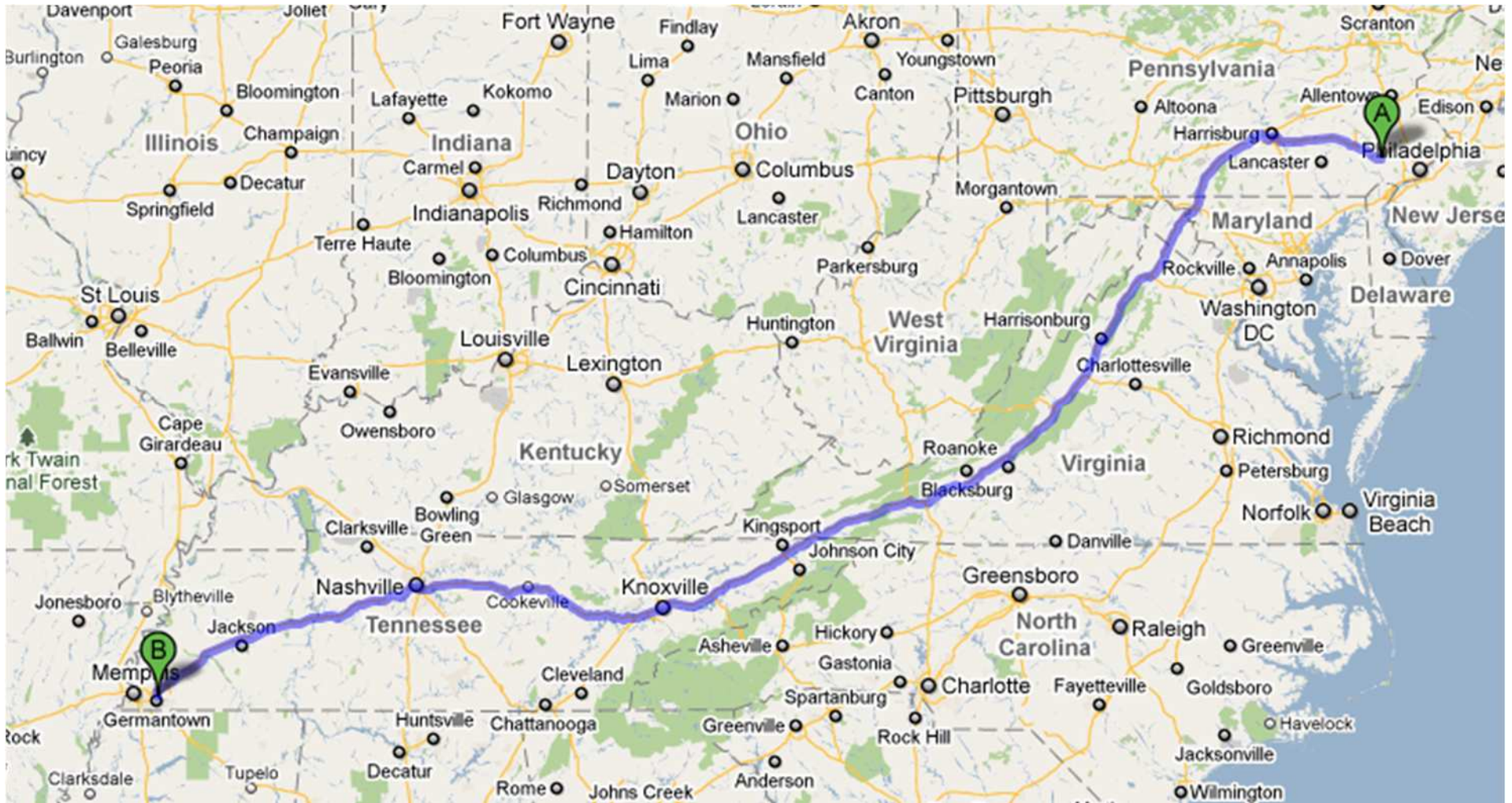
Travel I-40 east across the bridge into downtown Memphis, follow I-40 to I-240 east. Take Walnut Grove (exit 13) heading east. Go east on Walnut Grove approximately 2 ½ miles. Turn right into the Agricenter entrance... Agricenter Expo Center is the large grayish white building on the right past the Ducks Unlimited entrance, Show Place Arena is the large yellowish building on your left past the Farmer's Market (Red Barn).

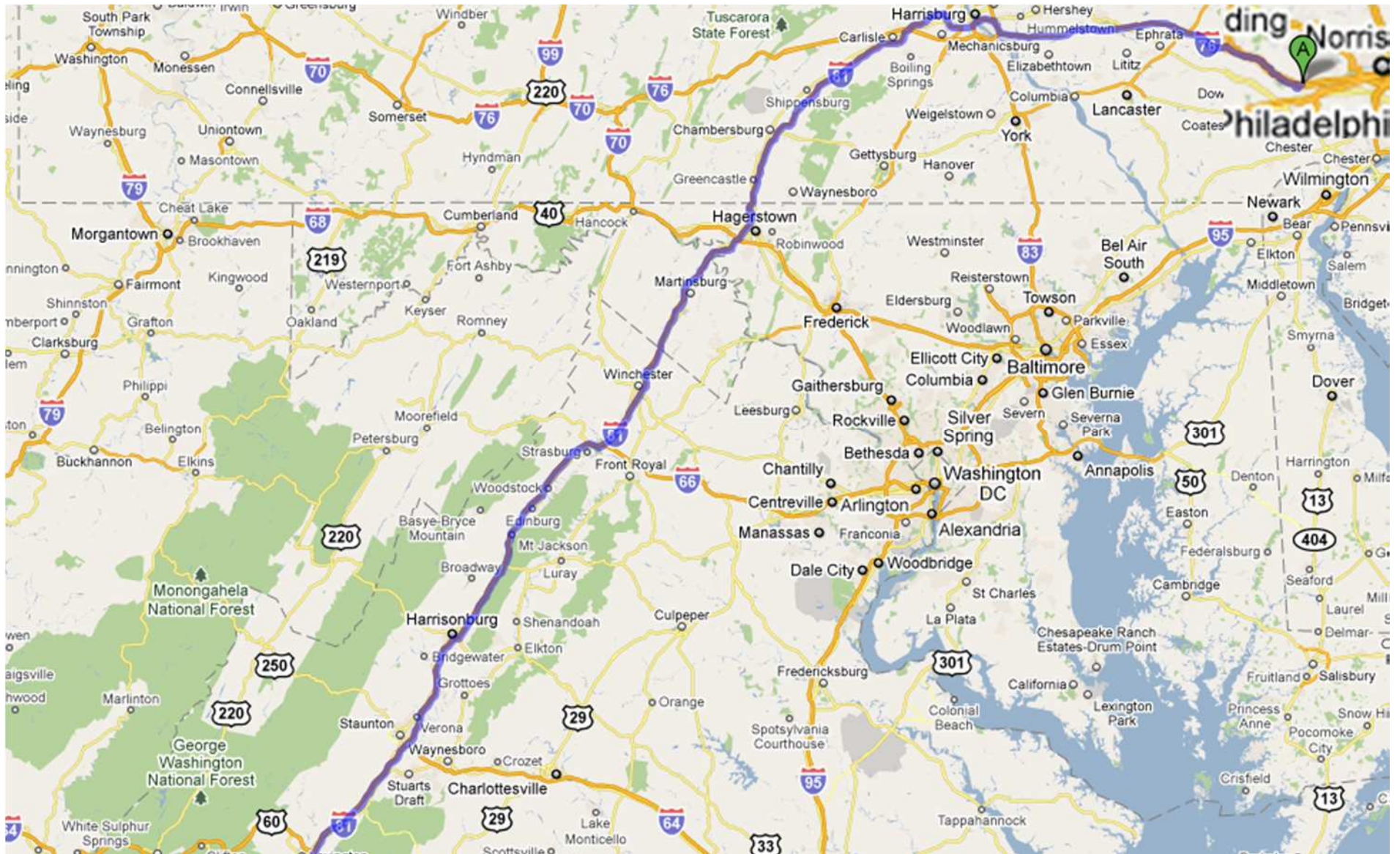
From Jackson, Mississippi:

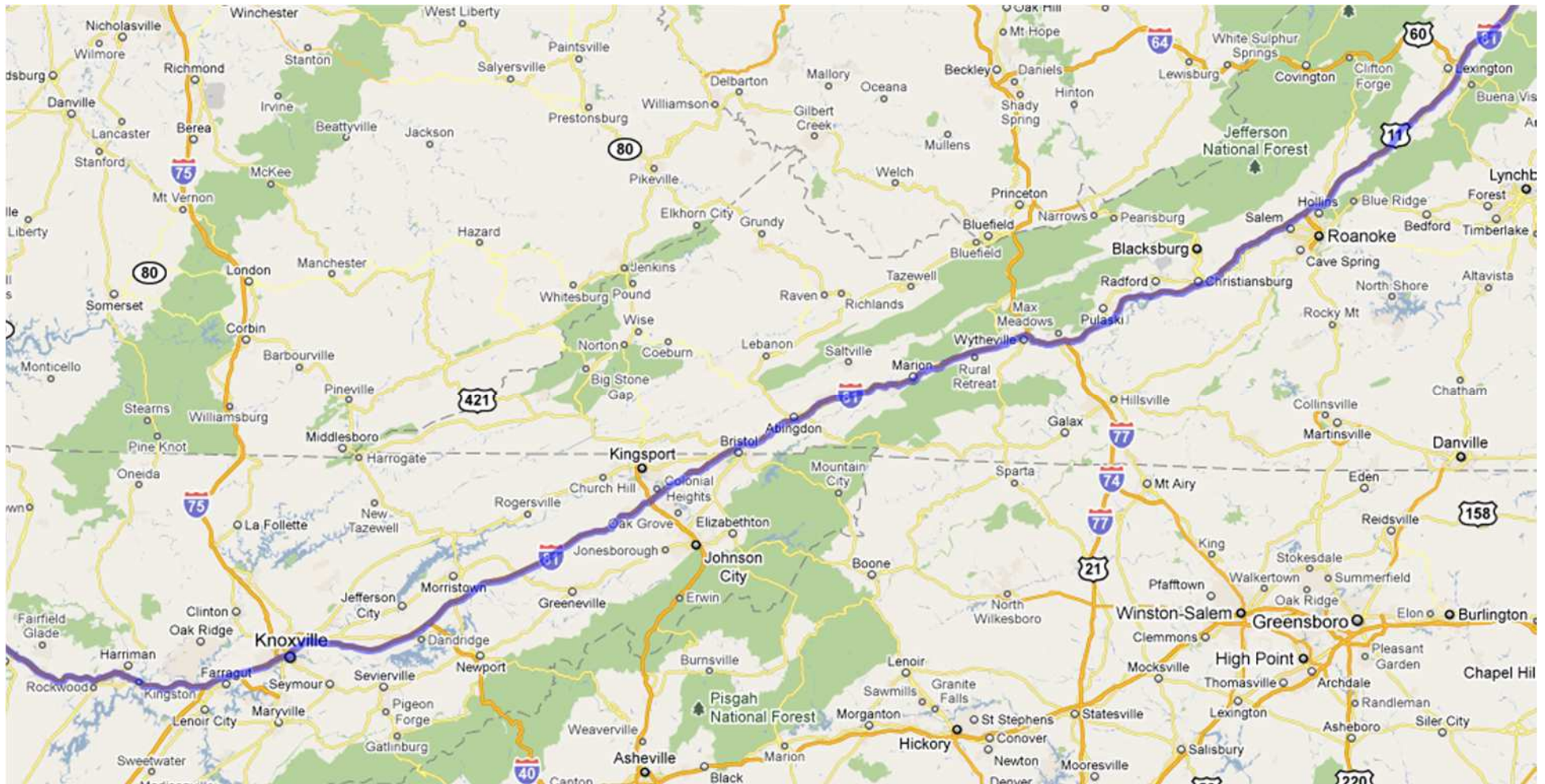

Agricenter Expo Center is the large grayish white building on the right past the Ducks Unlimited entrance, Show Place Arena is the large yellowish building on your left past the Farmer's Market (Red Barn).

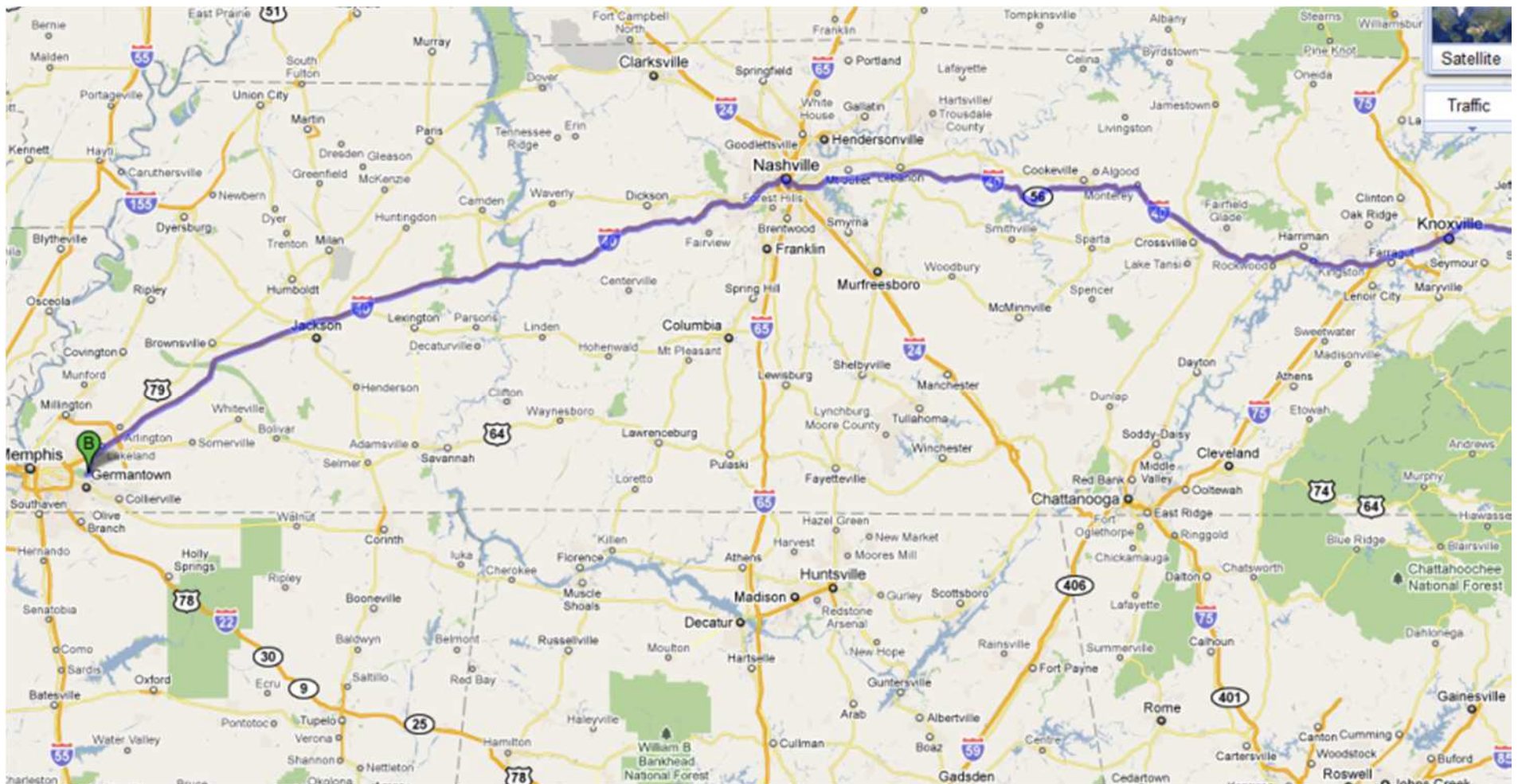

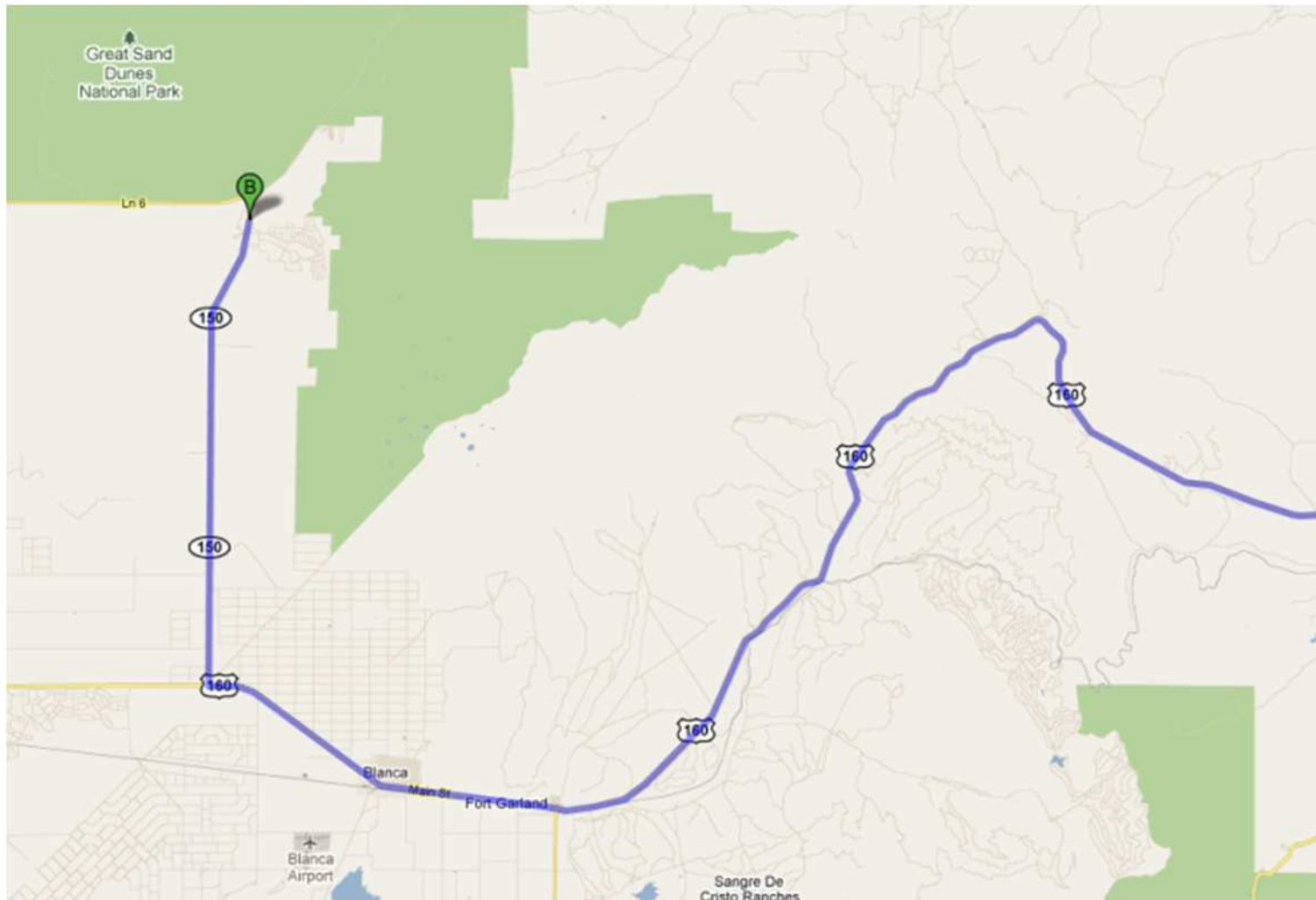


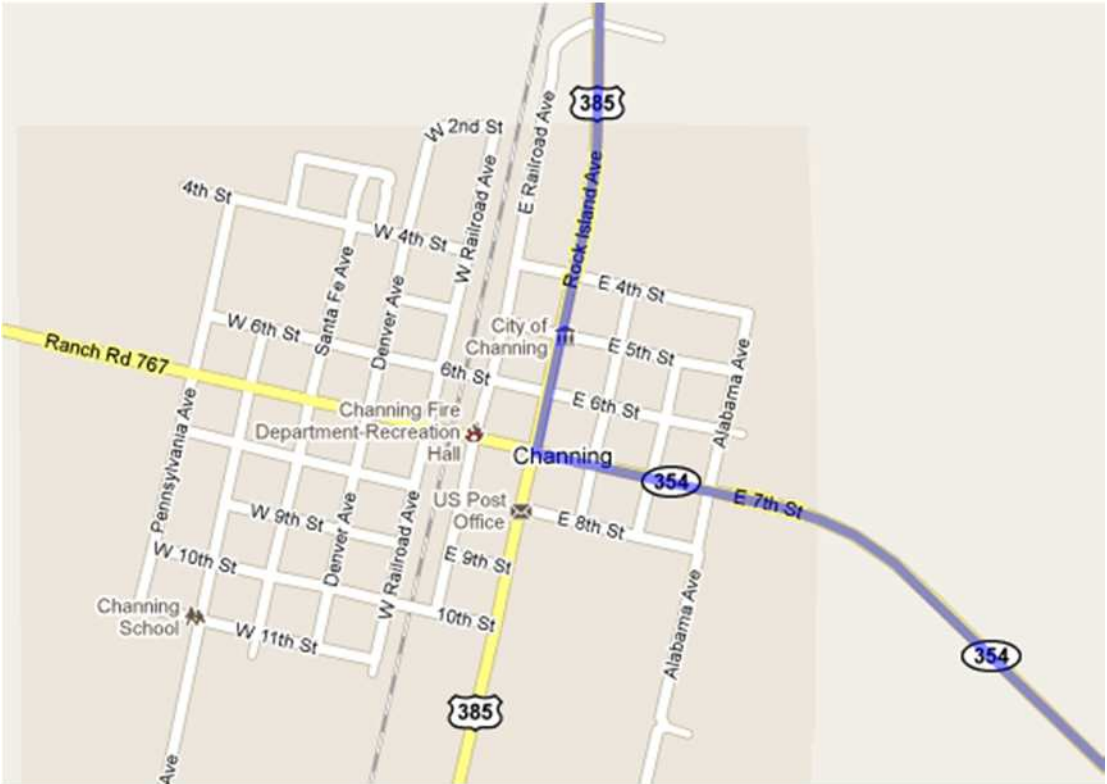
On the eastern side of the remote, high-mountain San Luis Valley, between the Blanca Massif and Crestone Needle, are the Great Sand Dunes, the tallest sand dunes in North America. The dunes cover approximately 39 square miles and rise to almost 750' above the valley floor.

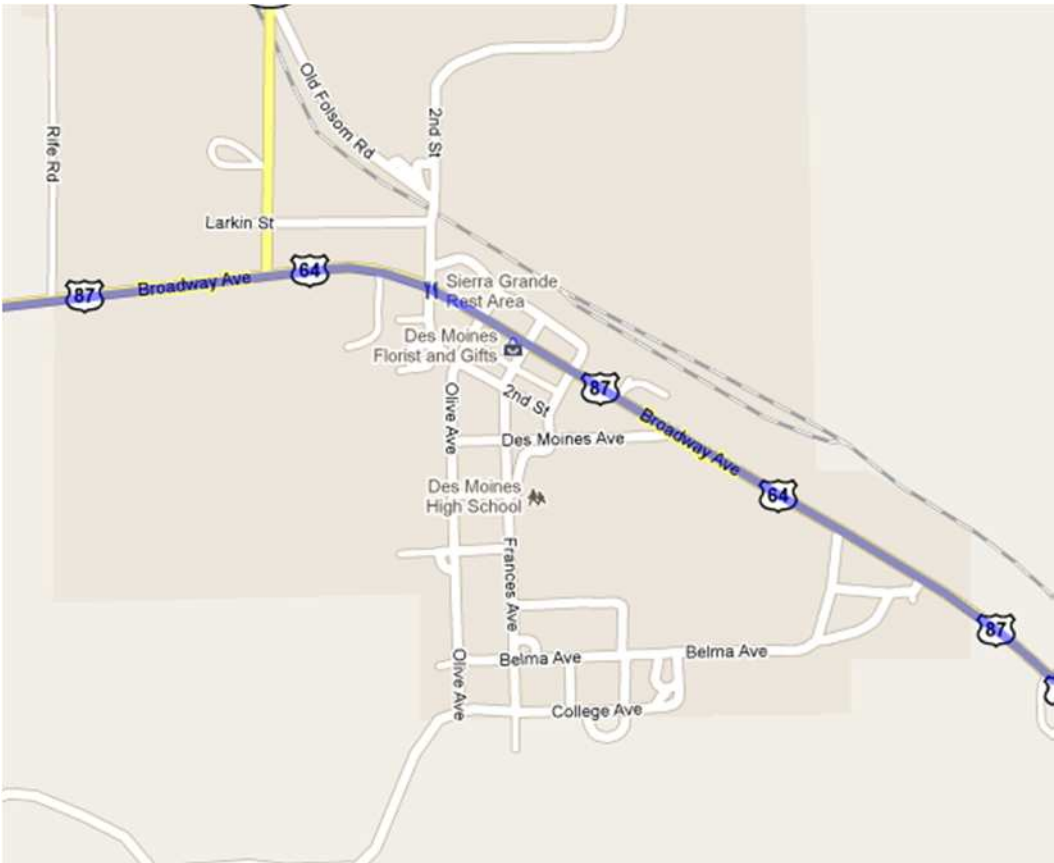
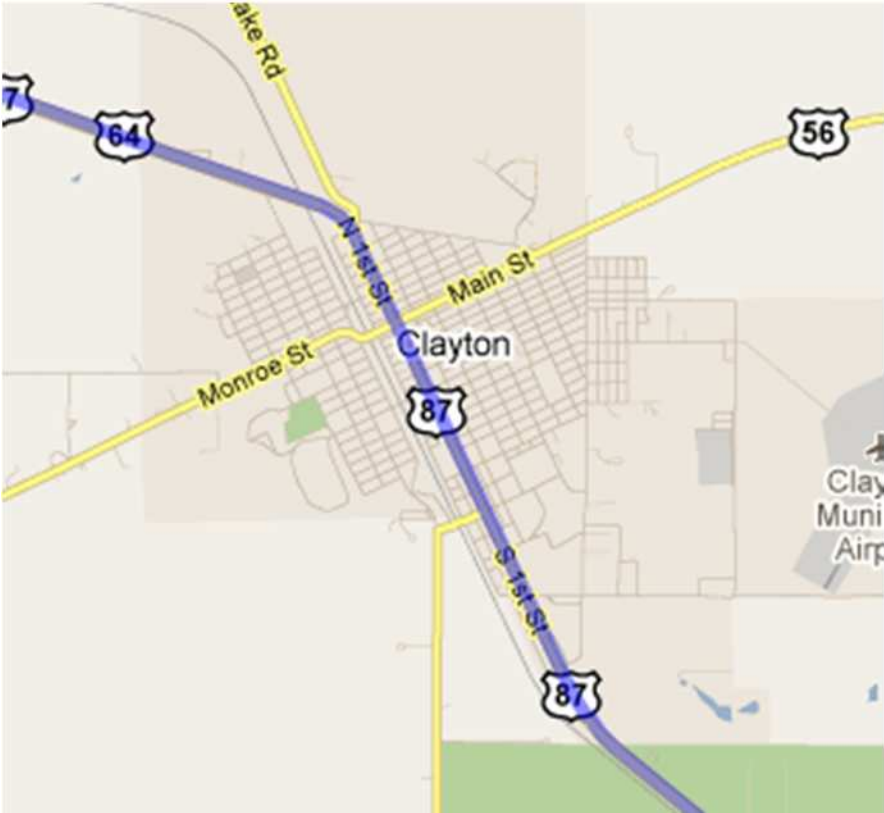
The dunes are the product of the wind and rain eroding the San Juan and Sangre de Cristo Mountains that ring the San Luis Valley. They have collected here because the prevailing winds across the valley blow in this direction. But here, at the foot of the mountains, the wind has to drop some of its load of sand in order to clear the mountains. So over the course of millennia, the dunes have built up to where they are today. And tomorrow they will be different because the wind still blows and still moves and deposits more sand here.

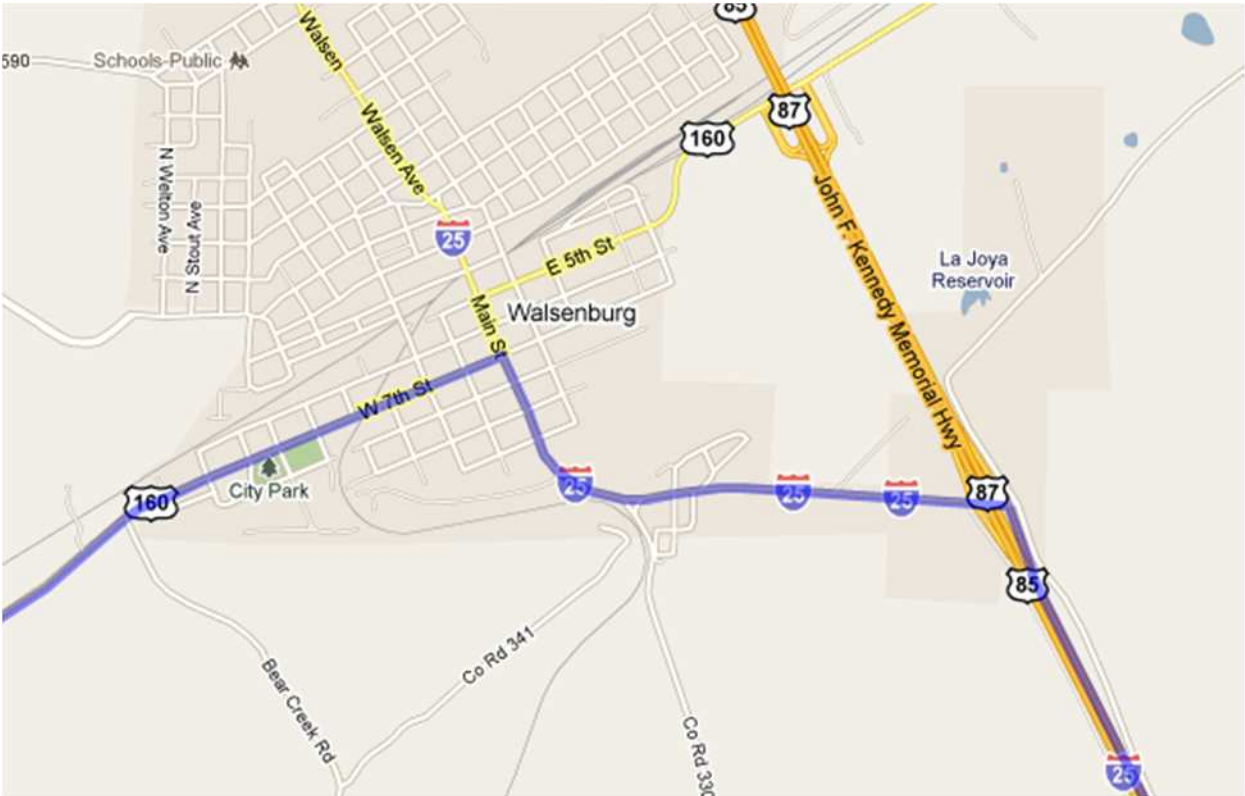

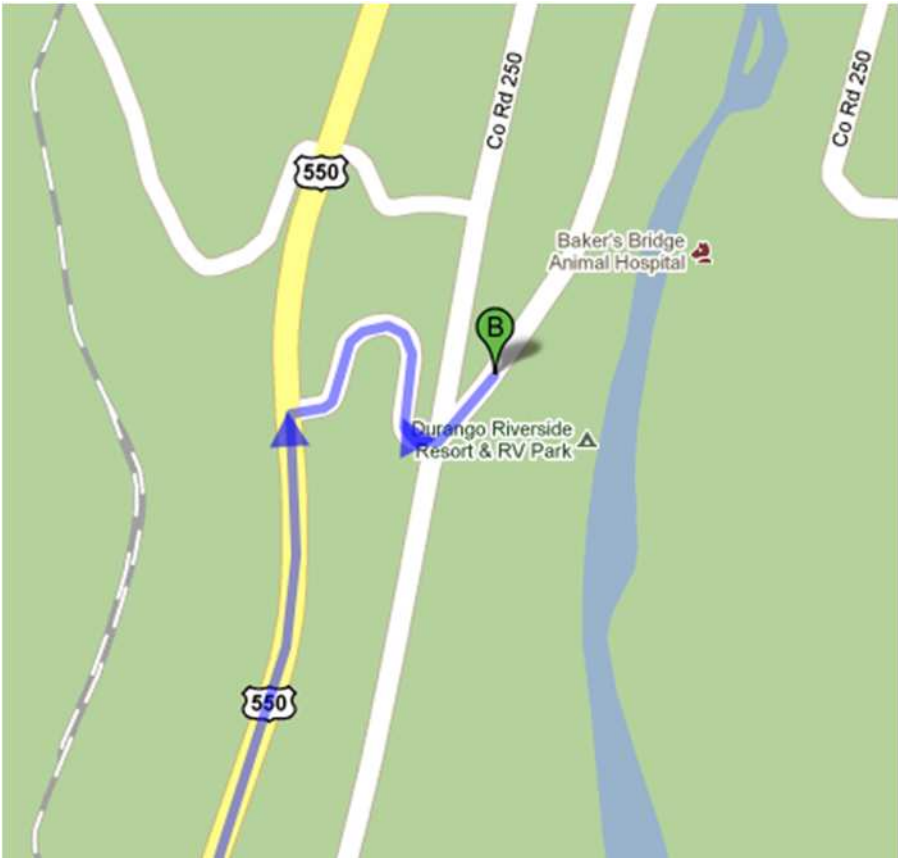
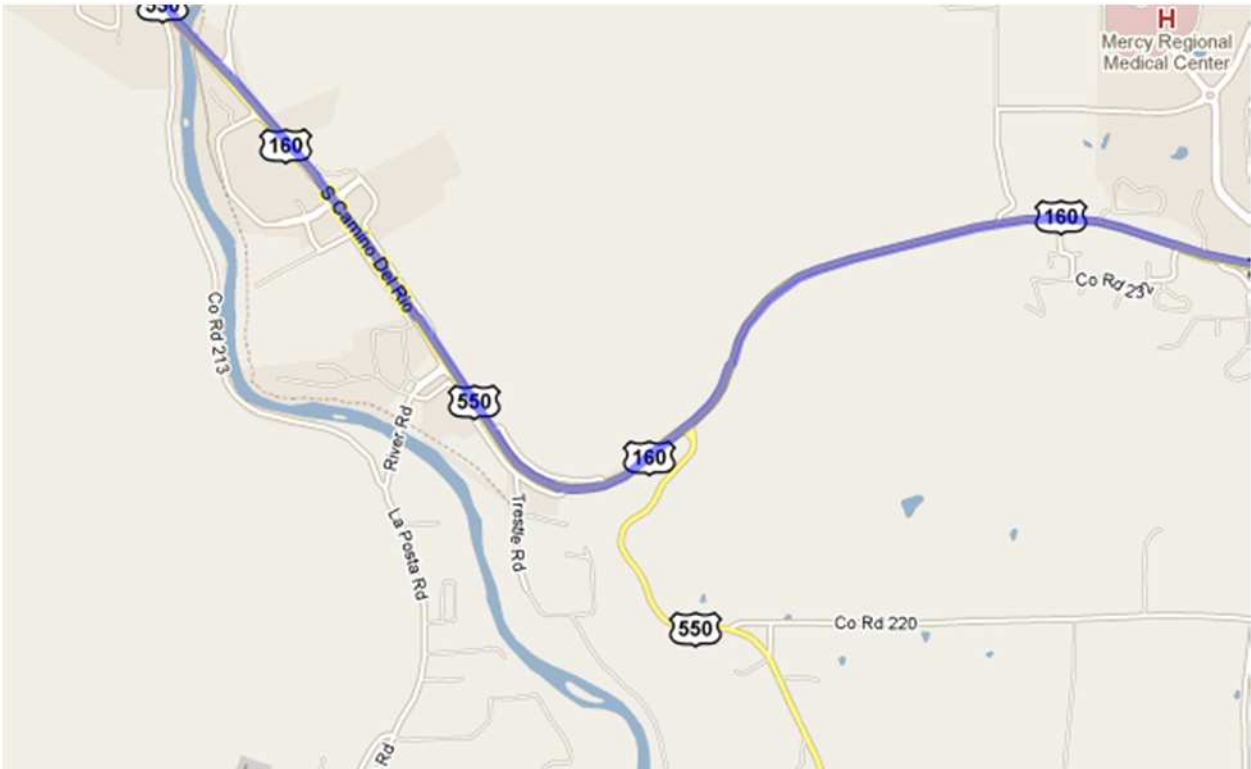

12 miles north of Durango. Traveling north on HWY 550, you will pass a small village named Hermosa. You're almost here. Continue north three and a half miles and look for a rock formation on your right, with hot springs bubbling from the top (pictured below). There is a pullout, plaque, and usually someone taking pictures! Once you see the rock, take the next right (about 100 yds from rock) which is County Road 250. You will wind down the hill and right into our park!

If using a GPS change your routing options to Freeway Only.

South on 101

Cross the Golden Gate Bridge (Toll) staying in the right hand lane. Follow signs for Hwy 1 South. Merge onto I280. Take Exit 47B Hwy 1 to Pacifica. After approximately 2 miles take Exit 507 Manor Dr/Palmetto Ave. Bear left at end of off ramp onto Palmetto. Go past Safeway. Go straight at 4-way Stop. We are a block and a half on the right.

From I580 or I80

Cross the Bay Bridge (Toll). Take Exit 431 I280 to Daly City. Take Exit 47B Hwy 1 to Pacifica. After approximately 2 miles take Exit 507 Manor Dr/Palmetto Ave. Bear left at end of off ramp onto Palmetto. Go past Safeway. Go straight at 4-way Stop. We are a block and a half on the right.

I5 North from Los Angeles

Take Exit 403B Hwy 152 West to Gilroy. Follow instructions below for North on 101.

North on 101

Coming north on 101 south of San Jose take Hwy 85 North to I280 North to Exit 47 Hwy 1 South to Pacifica. (DO NOT take I280 exit 41 Hwy 35 to Pacifica)! After approximately 2 miles take Exit 507 Manor Dr/Palmetto Ave. Bear left at end of off ramp onto Palmetto. Go past Safeway. Go straight at 4-way Stop. We are a block and a half on the right.

North on Hwy 1

Take Exit 507 Manor Dr/Monterey Rd. At end of off ramp turn left at 4-way stop. Turn left at next 4-way stop. Turn left at next 4-way stop (Walgreens). We are a block and a half on the right.
